



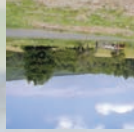

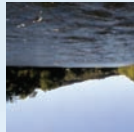

Orange Route



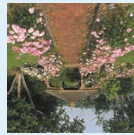

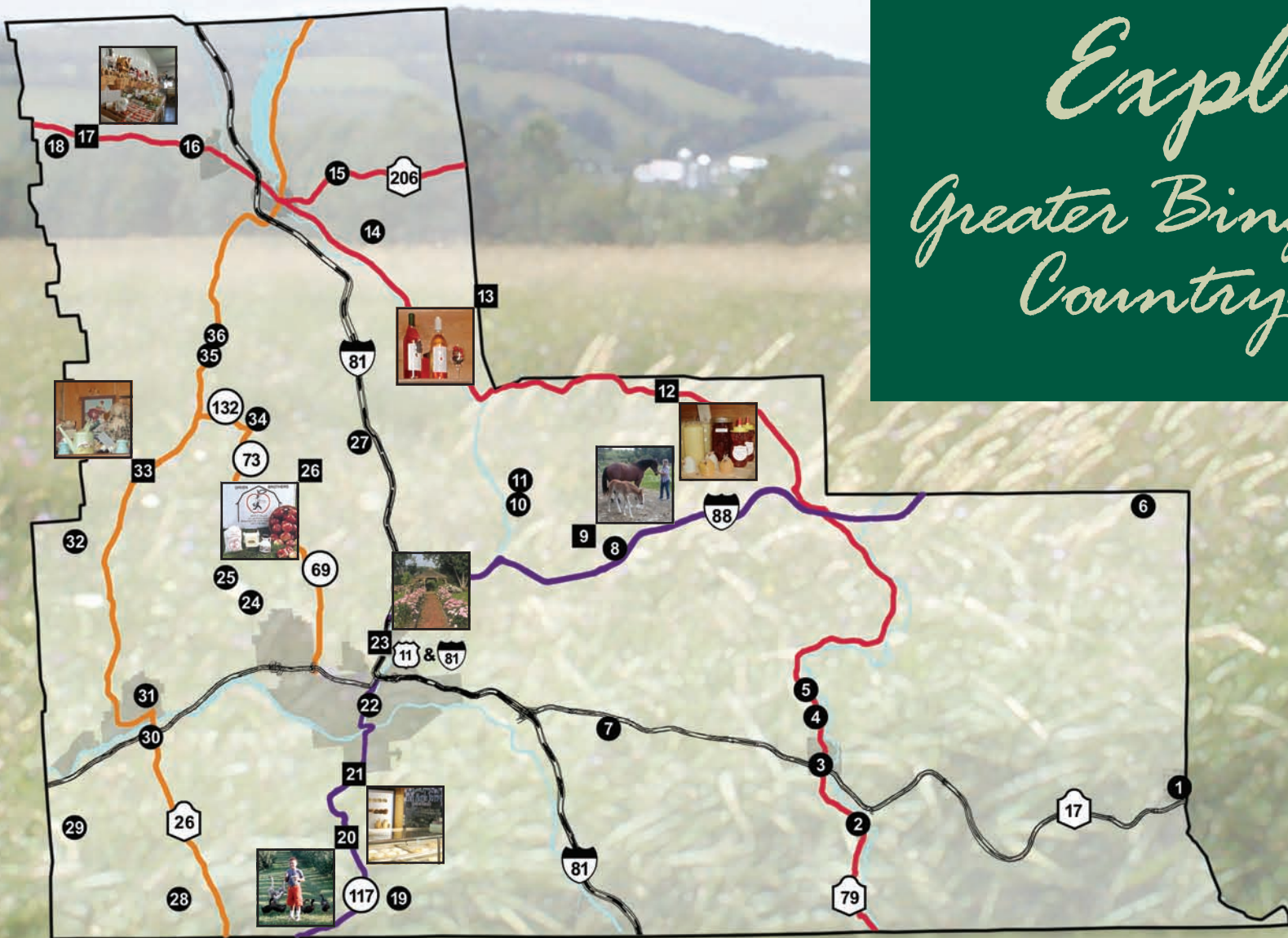

Take ramp for Exit 5 Southbound, and you will see the Cutler Botanic Garden to your right in the circle of the interchange "cloverleaf". Turn right at the light, which is Upper Front St, and enter next driveway into our parking lot.
